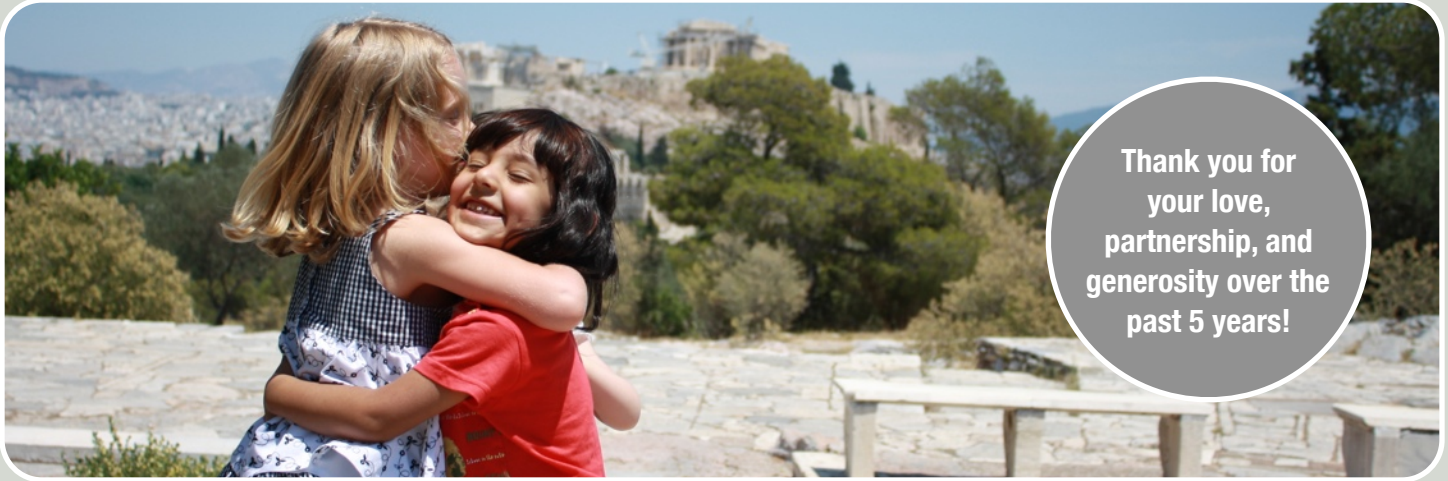

It's hard to believe that we've been back in the US for three months now! We've updated our sending churches and reconnected with many of you. At the moment, we're staying outside of Springfield (IL) as Brett continues to pursue the right pastoral role. Until then, Brett is working at a bookstore and teaching as much as possible at churches, retreats, and other special events.

Kristin and the girls are adjusting well to life in the US. Kristin is working a couple of days a week at a local gym (childcare). And although the kids miss their friends in Greece, they are having fun making new friends and spending time with cousins and grandparents.
